


Access MyLab or Mastering in Canvas through RedShelf LINK

Launch Pearson content

1. Enter your Canvas course and locate RedShelf LINK

Important The name and location of the app may vary based on the set up of the course. In the example below, select the Modules left menu tab. Under the RedShelf Module, select Course Materials.



Under My Courses, your Pearson materials tied to this course will appear.


• If you are currently Opted In for course material access and you want to access your course materials, select the item that appears under **Your Materials**.




o If desired, select the I want to opt out of access to all required materials for this course to **Opt Out**.

3. Select Open MyLab & Mastering to launch your Pearson course.


