The second biennial Kentucky National will be a survey of the most interesting trends in contemporary art. It will encompass traditional and new media and will be open to all professional artists living and working in the United States.

JUROR, ROBIN CLARK

Dr. Robin Clark is Associate Curator of Contemporary Art at the St. Louis Art Museum. Recent projects include serving as curator or assistant curator on exhibits such as: Eva Hesse, Diane Arbus, Sigmar Polke, and Francis Cape. Robin Clark has curated exhibits at the Museum of Contemporary Art, Los Angeles, the Guggenheim Museum, and the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art. Dr. Clark received a PhD in art history from the City University of New York.

TO ENTER

There is a non-refundable entry fee of \$25.00 (U.S.) per artist for five slide entries (or DVD/VHS as appropriate). Resumes, Artist Statements, or Bios may be included with entries. Make checks payable to: Eagle Gallery. Each slide must be mounted in a standard 2 by 2" plastic or paper mount (no glass) and labeled with the following information: your name, the title, media, dimensions and top of slide (indicated by an arrow or red dot, lower left). Mail slides, entry fee, a #10 SASE and entry form to:

AWARDS & CATALOG

A prize fund is guaranteed for Best of Show, Second, and Third places. Award money is dependent upon the number of entries received. An exhibition catalog will be produced with reproductions of work by all accepted artists. All accepted artists will receive one complimentary copy. Award winners will be invited for solo and small group exhibits in 2006-2007.

ELIGIBILITY

The show is open to all professional artists, 18 years and over. Each artist is limited to five entries—all media accepted. The work must be original, completed recently and not previously shown in Eagle Gallery. Size restrictions: pieces must fit easily on a freight elevator, call for exact dimensions.

An artist statement will be requested from all accepted artists.

Accepted video artists may supply equipment or be added to a looped tape with other video artwork on one screen.

SHIPPING

Shipping to and from the gallery is the responsibility of the artist. Work will be returned via the artist's preferred shipper.


