

BFA Jury Creation Form

To the Student:

After passing your **ART 298 Mid-Degree-Review** and choosing to pursue a BFA Degree you must form a BFA Practicum Jury. Once you have chosen an area of emphasis you must get the approval of the major professor in that emphasis. That professor will serve as your BFA Practicum Jury's Chairperson. You must have two other department of Art faculty members willing to serve on your BFA Jury. Your BFA Practicum Jury will then meet with you each semester to assist you in your progress toward your ART 498—BFA Practicum Exhibition. The first two meetings will take place at a designated time. You must schedule your final meeting with your jury and the gallery director four weeks prior to your BFA Exhibition.

Check List:

- You must have a major professor and two other art faculty to complete your jury (minimum, 2 studio faculty).
- You will participate in three semesters of BFA committee reviews.
- Your third BFA review will take place 4 weeks before your BFA Exhibition.
- You may switch your degree plan to a BA/BS at any time.
- You may choose an inter-area emphasis, with two areas represented. You must still choose a Jury Chairperson.
- You must maintain a 3.0 GPA in your area of emphasis.
