


# Connecting an iPhone to MSUsecure

With the recent growth of mobile wireless devices on Murray State University's campus and in an effort to ease Bluesocket authentication procedures and increase network security on these devices, Information Systems has created MSUsecure, a WPA-encrypted, 802.1x-authenticated secure wireless network deployed alongside the standard, open MSUwireless network. The following steps will walk you through connecting your iPhone to MSUsecure quickly and automatically.

## Step 1.

Click the **Settings** icon  on your iPhone's home screen to open the iPhone Preferences pane. From the settings pane, select Wi-Fi.



## Step 2.

Turn on Wi-Fi at the top of the page, then select **MSUsecure** from the available networks list.



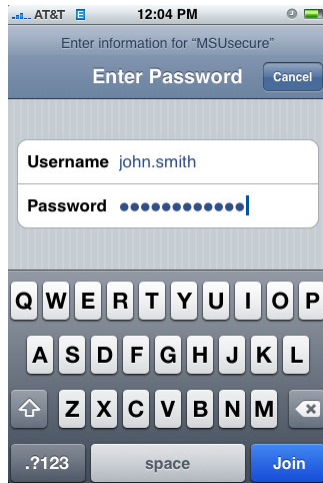
*\*Note: If you do not see MSUsecure or MSUwireless in the available networks list, you may not be in a location covered by Murray State's wireless network.*

## Step 3.

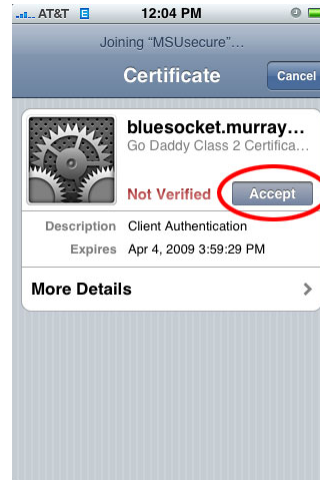
You will be prompted for your MSUNET2K username and password. Enter your credentials and select **Join**.



*\*Note: If authentication fails, double-check your username and password. For questions, call the Help Desk at (270) 809-2346.*

## Step 4.

Click **Accept** when presented with the Bluesocket security certificate.



**Congratulations!** You are now authenticated and connected to the MSUsecure wireless network.

Your iPhone will remember your credentials and authenticate automatically until your network password is changed. When your password is changed you will be prompted for your new password the next time you access the wireless network. In addition, all of your wireless communication with the MSUsecure network is now secured using industry-standard WPA wireless encryption.
